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Asesiad Poblogaeth – a. 14

Rhaid i awdurdod lleol a bwrdd iechyd lleol asesu'r canlynol **ar y cyd**:

- Hyd a lled anghenion gofal a chymorth y boblogaeth leol;
- Hyd a lled yr anghenion cymorth i ofalwyr;
- I ba raddau y mae'r anghenion hynny'n cael eu bodloni;
- Ystod a lefel y gwasanaethau sydd eu hangen er mwyn bodloni'r anghenion gofal a chymorth a nodwyd;
- **Ystod a lefel y gwasanaethau ataliol sydd eu hangen.**

Population Assessment - s.14

An LA and LHB must **jointly assess**:

- The extent of the care and support needs of the local population;
- The extent of support needs for carers;
- The extent to which those needs are being met;
- The range and level of services needed to meet the care and support needs identified;
- **The range and level of preventative services needed.**

Asesiad Poblogaeth – a.15

- Mae adran 15 yn ei gwneud hi'n ofynnol i awdurdodau lleol drefnu bod **gwasanaethau ataliol** yn cael eu darparu i atal, gohirio neu leihau'r angen am ofal a chymorth. Mae atal yn thema sy'n rhedeg drwy'r Ddeddf a dylai fod wrth wraidd pob agwedd o gyflenwi gofal a chymorth.

Population Assessment - s.15

- Section 15 requires an LA to provide or arrange for the provision of **preventative services** to prevent, delay or reduce need for care and support. Prevention is a theme than runs through the Act and should underpin all aspects of the delivery of care and support.

A. 14 – Rheoliadau

- Mae'r rheoliadau o dan **Adran 14** yn nodi'r gofynion ar gyfer:
 - i. Cyhoeddi a chymeradwyo'r adroddiad asesiadau poblogaeth;
 - ii. Cyfnodau amser;
 - iii. Adolygu;
 - iv. Ymgysylltu â Dinas syddion a Darparwyr Gwasanaeth
- Mae **Adran 166** o'r Ddeddf yn rhoi pwerau gwneud rheoliadau i Weinidogion Cymru ofyn am drefniadau partneriaeth benodol. Bydd **ymarfer asesu ar y cyd** yn cael ei gynnal ym mhob ardal Bwrdd Iechyd Lleol gyda'r awdurdodau lleol yn yr ardal honno.

S.14 - Regulations

- Regulations under **Section 14** set out requirements for:
 - i. Publication & approval of the population assessment report;
 - ii. Timescales;
 - iii. Review;
 - iv. Citizen and Service Provider Engagement
- **Section 166** of the Act provides Welsh Ministers with regulation making powers to require specified partnership arrangements. A **combined assessment exercise** will be undertaken in each LHB area with the local authorities in that area.

Population Assessment and the Preventative Agenda

Bydd Adroddiad yr Asesiad Poblogaeth yn rhoi gwybodaeth werthfawr i gefnogi:

- penderfyniadau ynghylch adnoddau a chyllidebau;
- cynlluniau llesiant newydd;
- byrddau partneriaeth i sicrhau bod gwasanaethau a deilliannau wedi'u targedu, yn gynaliadwy, yn effeithiol ac yn effeithlon

The Population Assessment Report will provide valuable information to support:

- resource and budgetary decisions;
- new well-being plans;
- partnership boards to ensure services and outcomes are targeted, sustainable, effective and efficient

Byrddau Partneriaeth Rhanbarthol a'u haelodaeth

- Mae a.166 o'r Ddeddf yn caniatáu i Weinidogion Cymru bennu'r trefniadau partneriaeth. Mae'r rhain wedi eu hamlinellu yn *Rheoliadau Trefniadau Partneriaeth (Cymru) 2015*

Regional Partnership Boards and membership

- S.166 of the Act allows Welsh Ministers to specify the partnership arrangements. These are set out in the new *Partnership Arrangements (Wales) Regulations 2015*

Regional Partnership boards will consist of:

- At least one elected LA member
- At least one member of the LHB
- The Director of Social Services in each authority
- An LHB representative
- Two people representing the interests of the third sector
- At least one person representing the interests of care providers
- One person to represent people with needs for care and support and one person to represent carers.

Trefniadau partneriaeth a rôl Byrddau Partneriaeth Rhanbarthol

- Rhaid i Awdurdodau Lleol a'r Bwrdd Iechyd Lleol gydweithio fel bwrdd partneriaeth i wella deilliannau a llesiant pobl, yn ogystal â gwella effeithlonrwydd y broses o gyflenwi gwasanaethau.
- Bydd hyn yn seiliedig ar yr adroddiad asesiad poblogaeth ar y cyd.

Partnership arrangements and the role of Regional Partnership Boards

- LAs and the LHB must work together as a partnership board to improve outcomes and the well-being of people, as well as improving the efficiency of service delivery.
- This will be informed by the combined population assessment report.

Nodau allweddol y trefniadau partneriaeth:

- Gwella gofal a chymorth, gan sicrhau bod gan bobl fwy o lais a mwy o reolaeth;
- Gwella deilliannau a gwella iechyd a llesiant
- Darparu gofal a chymorth cydgysylltiedig sy'n canolbwytio ar unigolion;
- Defnyddio adnoddau, sgiliau ac arbenigedd yn fwy effeithiol;
- Sicrhau capaciti digonol a gwasanaethau o ansawdd da i ymateb i anghenion pobl yn y rhanbarth.

Key aims of the partnership arrangements:

- Improving care and support, ensuring people have more say and control;
- Improving outcomes and health and well-being;
- Providing co-ordinated, person centred care and support;
- Making more effective use of resources, skills and expertise;
- Ensuring sufficient capacity and good quality services to respond to the needs of people in the region.

Cefnogi Cyflenwi – gan gynnwys sefydlu cronfeydd cyfun

Supporting Delivery- including establishment of pooled funds

- Bydd dull integredig o gomisiynu a chyflenwi gwasanaethau o gymorth i'r awdurdodau lleol a'r Bwrdd Iechyd Lleol gael mwy o ddylanwad ar ffurf gwasanaethau a'r ffordd y cânt eu cyflenwi.
- An integrated approach to the commissioning and provision of services will assist both the local authorities and Local health Board to exercise greater influence over the shape and delivery of services.

Mae'r dull integredig hwn wedi'i gefnogi gan y gofyniad yn Rheoliadau Trefniadau Partneriaeth (Cymru) 2015 i sefydlu **cronfeydd cyfun**, o **6 Ebrill 2016**, ar gyfer:

- cyflawni swyddogaethau cymorth i deuluoedd;
- swyddogaethau a gyflawnir ar y cyd **o ganlyniad i asesiad a wneir o dan a14 o'r Ddeddf.**

Ac o **6 Ebrill 2018** ar gyfer:

- cyflawni swyddogaethau llety cartrefi gofal.

This integrated approach is supported by the requirement of The Partnership Arrangements (Wales) Regulations 2015 to establish, from **6 April 2016**, **pooled funds** in relation to:

- the exercise of family support functions;
- functions that will be exercised jointly **as a result of an assessment** carried out under s14 of the Act.

And from **6 April 2018** in relation to:

- the exercise of care home accommodation functions.

- Bydd partneriaid yn parhau i fod â chyfrifoldeb statudol am y swyddogaethau y maent yn eu cyflawni o dan yr holl drefniadau cronfa gyfun. Dylai'r cytundeb partneriaeth gynnwys trefniadau llywodraethu perthnasol, gan gynnwys atebolrwydd, prosesau penderfynu a sut y bydd cyllidebau cyfun yn cael eu rheoli.
- Partners will retain statutory responsibility for their functions carried out under all pooled fund arrangements. The partnership agreement should include relevant governance arrangements including accountability, decision making and how pooled budgets will be managed.

Why are we doing a toolkit?

- To support LAs, LHBs and partners to undertake an population assessment and produce a report
- Developed by SSIA in partnership with Public Health Wales
- Supported by a steering group of key partners
- Available from April 2016

What will it do?

- Supporting not prescribing
- Allow for each area to produce it's own report in line with local priorities
- Include all requirements listed in Act and Code of Practice
- Provide links to data, intelligence and relevant information (support to identify, gather and interpret information)
- Situation and response analysis approach
- Interactive document – live and updateable

How we developed it

Cwm Taf pilot area

- One group looking at population assessment and local wellbeing plans (Wellbeing Future Generations)
- Learning from their process to develop the toolkit
- Toolkit will not advocate one process over another but will draw on good practice in the Cwm Taf area

Learning from other partners (LAs, LHBs, inspectorate, universities and third sector)

Steering Group meets every two months to advise on development

Content

- How to use the toolkit
- Summary of requirements, including
 - Core Themes (to also include other themes, e.g. offenders/secure estate)
 - Range and Level of Services
- Engagement
- Prevention and Preventative Services
- Identifying and responding to unmet need

What have we been told?

Issues identified in our discussions:

- Ideas for good engagement
